

Coffee Farm & Roasting Combo

STYLE: Cultural

Get fitted with a traditional picker's basket and head out to the coffee farm to learn what the process for coffee harvesting. You'll learn how they determine the quality of the beach and how many beans go into one cup of coffee!

Next you'll watch the coffee be sorted in 'Parijuelas', and learn the importance of the drying process. You can try roasting coffee in a 70-year old wood burning stove using a turn of the century hand roaster as well as grind the fresh-roasted coffee beans in a grinding machine dating back to 1875.

Enjoy a sample of fresh brewed light, medium and dark roasts, plus chocolate-covered coffee beans.

Coffee Roasting Tour

STYLE: Cultural

Tour begins with a quick overview of the different stages of coffee during the dry milling process. Tío Ramón's house, built in 1930, is still home to original furnishings from the late 19th and early 20th centuries. This house is where the coffee is roasted in a 70 year old wood burning stove using a turn of the century hand roaster. After the coffee is roasted, you will grind the fresh-roasted coffee beans in a grinding machine dating from 1875.

The final stage prior to the tasting is the brewing of the coffee that you just ground and enjoy a sample of fresh brewed light, medium and dark roasts, plus coffee liqueurs and chocolate-covered coffee beans.

A guided hike through the national park is the best way to learn about the history of the volcano and the surrounding wildlife around the volcano. The 2 km hike is designed to look for a variety of wildlife including deer, monkeys, snakes, toucans, and much more! There is a wide range of plants growing in the area including bromeliads, ceiba, cirri, laurel and fungi.

On a clear day you will have great views of the Arenal Volcano, Arenal lake and the neighboring 3500-year old extinct volcano Cerro Chato. This excursion is a great way of learning about the natural history of the area. Hiking is intermediate & you will experience gravel and loose rock on the lava beds.

It offers over 45 contionuous rapids along its 16 kilometers of deep-canyon gorges-more than any other river in Costa Rica. Here you often see sloths, monkeys and tropical birds, such as toucans and the Montezuma oropendula.

If river conditions are unsuitable for the Toro river, our head guide might make the call to change to a back-up river of similar or equal level which is only 20-minutes futher and/or offer another tour, such as our half-day whitewater raft tour on the Río Balsa

Kayak on Peñas Blancas River

Continue hiking for another 1.5 hours; see the famous waterfall and bubbling hot springs. Have a hearty local meal at Don Pedros restaurant before returning to Arenal.

Sky Tram & Sky Trek Tour

Board a gondola and soar through the rainforest taking in the incredible views of the mountainous area. There you can see the rainforest, Lake Arenal and on clear days you can even see the Nicaragua Lake!

Sky Trek is the zipline part of the tour. It consists of a system of zip lines that allows you to observe the rainforest and its landscape from above the canopy. The tour includes 8 cross-sectional cables that together have a total length of 1.7 miles with distances from 100 to 2460 feet and a maximum height of 660 feet. This is one of the longest ziplines in the country.

Sky Tram, Trek & Walk Combo

Ascend to the continental divide on this high technology cableway that includes a ride of one mile with altitudes between 4500 to 5250 feet above sea level. After an exciting tram ride, get ready for the Sky Trek Canopy tour! Ride down on a circuit of ziplines stretching across deep canyons and between treetops.

Sky Walk offers you another opportunity to get a perspective on the dynamic rainforest at a much slower pace. Here you can enjoy two amazing waterfalls, and a stunning cantilever platform 100 feet high with spectacular views of the forest, volcano and lake.

Nocturnal Sky Tram & Sky Trek

This is an adventurous way of experiencing the rainforest at night. Ride in a tram car over the rainforest and hear the sounds of wildlife all around you. Your local bilingual guide will explain what you are hearing and you could possibly see some nocturnal animals. The tram can be stopped at any time to spot wildlife and take photos.

The guide will then take you through a safety talk about the canopy zipline. You will be fitted with your harness, helmet and gloves before setting off along 10 zip line cables that range in length from 200 to 750 meters.

Horseback Riding to La Fortuna Waterfall

STYLE: Nature & Family

After getting suited up with your gear and a short riding demonstration, you will be assigned your horse for the day! Your horseback riding adventure begins as you pass local cattle farms and tropical forests, all with stunning views of the Arenal Volcano and the rainforest. Stop at the replica of a Maleku Indigenous tribe 'palenque' to learn a little about one of Costa Rica's few remaining indigenous tribes from this area. After another short ride, you'll take a 20-minute hike to get to the base of a 230-foot high waterfall. You can swim a little before returning back to your horse.

La Fortuna Waterfall by Van/Car

A 20-minute drive will take you through local cattle farms and agricultulture. After that, spend 20-minutes hiking downhill into the forest until you reach the base of the 230-foot high La Fortuna waterfall. Swim in the fresh water and enjoy the stunning rainforest and wildlife all around you for one hour. Relax with some drinks and snacks before hiking back up to the car to go back to your hotel.

Venado Caves Tour

This is a great option for adventurous couples, friends and families with an interest in learning about Costa Rican geology. Spend 1.5-hours climbing, crawling and walking through the cave, passing underground rivers along the way! Do not be surprised if you get wet & dirty! See marine fossils, bats, spiders, snakes, scorpions and centipedes! Parts of the cave have narrow openings where you will crawl to get through; also there are some steep climbs!

Spot birds as you glide along and be in awe of the view of the Arenal Volcano! See if you can stay up or whether you end up going for a swim in the lake! Be prepared to get wet.

TOUR DURATION

Stated tour duration time is approximately the length of the tour and the transportation time to and from the activity. Dependiong on the location of your accommodation in Guanacaste area, these times may vary.

TIPS FOR TIPPING

Tipping is a personal choice, but you should know that most people who work in tourism here depend on tips as part of their income. While it's not expected; it's definitely very much appreciated. The amount you tip is based on the length of your tour as well as the service of your guides. For a short, half-day or less tour \$3-\$5/person is sufficient. For a longer or full-day tour \$7-\$10/person would be appropriate. Tipping for fishing trips is usually 10% of the cost of the fishing trip.
