The Carara Biological Reserve is located 1.5-hours from Quepos. On the way to the park, you will stop at the Tarcoles bridge adjacent to the park which is home to the second largest crocodiles in the world!

Once inside the park, enjoy a 2.5-hour hike with a naturalist guide through one of the most bio-diverse areas of Costa Rica. This is a great place to spot some rare species of birds as well as monkeys and sloths.

White Water River Rafting Naranjo **River Class 3-4**

The Naranjo drops from the mountains above Quepos, through a beautiful jungle gorge and takes you on a wild ride to sea level, passing nearby farmlands and palm plantations.

On most trips, rafters will observe egrets, osprey, toucans, parrots, kingfishers, cormorants, and many other species local to this protected area of the primary tropical rainforest. After a steady 13-mile trip down the river, you will head to the local village of "Silencio" to enjoy a well-deserved hot lunch (Tico style) and local refreshments.
